Safety and Security Simplified

The CarePoint resident safety system can provide integrated controlled access and wander management functionality through the implementation of the Controlled Access and Wander Management (CAWM) Module. The CAWM enables CarePoint to “speak” to common automatic door locking hardware such as magnetic locks and door strikes, and is also capable of interfacing with RoamAlert® wander management hardware. As a result, controlled access and wander management functionality can be added to CarePoint and controlled through a single, intuitive interface. This allows CarePoint to provide the functionality of three different systems, all through a single interface, using a single database. This can help reduce the number of different systems in your community, as well as staff training and database management requirements.

Gain Control

The CAWM acts as a universal translator between automated locking hardware and the CarePoint software – enabling centralized control and scheduling of the locked or unlocked state of any equipped door, from a single interface, on a resident-by-resident basis if necessary. The CAWM also has wireless capability, so it can be mated with a wireless link to speak to the CarePoint resident safety backbone. This can eliminate the need to run wire to more remote doors – helping to simplify installation and reduce cost.
